



WE'RE PLANNING NEW AFFORDABLE HOMES AT HOLLY OAK GARDENS

- 🏠 We want to make use of the current vacant land by creating a high-quality housing scheme that is in keeping with the surrounding area.
- 🏠 We plan to build 14 new one and two bedroom apartments, three storeys in design with landscaping and carparking.
- 🏠 The new homes will be for affordable rent, creating much-needed new affordable homes in the local area.
- 🏠 The new homes will be in a sustainable location, close to local amenities and public transport in Heywood town centre.
- 🏠 We will make sure that the new homes are designed and built with sensitivity to the local surrounding, with no negative impact on neighbouring homes.
- 🏠 The scheme will allow for the provision of soft landscaped areas surrounding the properties and car parking on the adjacent piece of land which is sensitive to the existing trees.
