




WE'RE PLANNING NEW AFFORDABLE HOMES ON BROWN STREET, LITTLEBOROUGH

We are working with our partners, The Casey Group, to develop proposals to build **40 new apartments**, all for affordable rent, at the location of the Storage Centre on Brown Street. **We'd love to hear your views about our plans.**

Our proposals would deliver brand new high quality affordable homes close to Littleborough town centre.

MORE DETAILS:

- We plan to provide a high quality housing scheme in keeping with its surroundings, with design features based on our award-winning building at Hare Hill.
- Our plans provide 40 new one and two bedroom apartments with shared communal gardens and parking
- We will provide much needed new homes for a genuine affordable rent
- The new apartments are in a sustainable location, close to the town centre with good access to the local facilities
- We want to make sure the plans enhance the local area for existing residents
- We'll make sure the new building fits in with the surroundings by including areas of soft landscaping
- You may be aware of an existing planning application on this site. Our proposals will deliver three additional homes compared to the current application but will be lower in height and further away from existing homes.
