The purpose RBH is processing your information is: to process your application to become a RBH member and fulfil your member rights to vote in Representative Body elections and attend formal Member Meetings. We will also use profiling data to monitor the make-up of our membership to enable us to address any under-representation.

Our legal basis for doing this is: It is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation.

The additional legal basis for processing protected categories of personal information is: to comply with Substantial Public Interest.

You are required to provide us with this information by: the Cooperative and Community Benefit Societies Act 2014.

As part of this processing your personal data may be shared with: Election Support Company, membership management software providers

All processing of your personal information will remain with in the UK.

Your personal information will then be kept on our records for: 6 years from end of membership.
